Supplemental tax bills are issued in addition to the annual tax bill, generally due to a change in ownership or new construction in accordance with Article XIII A of the California Constitution.

If you disagree with the assessed value as shown on your tax bill, you have the right to an informal assessment review by the Assessor-Recorder's Office. Visit [www.sf.gov/ASR](http://www.sf.gov/ASR) for more information. You also have the right to file an application for reduction in assessment for the following year by filing a written application with the Assessment Appeals Board, City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, Room 405, San Francisco, CA 94102. The filing period is July 2 to September 15. Visit [www.sfgov.org/aab](http://www.sfgov.org/aab) or call 415- 554-6778 for more information. If an informal or formal assessment review is requested, relief from penalties shall apply only to the difference between the Assessor-Recorder's final determination of value and the value on the assessment roll for the fiscal year covered.

**Property Tax Postponement for Senior Citizens, Blind, or Disabled Persons**

The State Controller's Office (SCO) administers the Property Tax Postponement (PTP) program, which allows eligible homeowners to postpone payment of current year property taxes on their primary residence. PTP applications are accepted from October 1 to February 10 each year. Go to the SCO website at [www.ptp.sco.ca.gov](http://www.ptp.sco.ca.gov) for more information. 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Did you...

Submit payment for the exact amount?

Confirm that you have sufficient funds in your account? If your payment is not honored by the bank, the payment is null and void and a \$50.00 "Payment Failure Fee" will be charged in addition to any late payment penalties.

If the delinquent date falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, no penalty is charged if payment is made by 5 PM on the next business day.

If any portion of the total amount due is unpaid after 5 PM on June 30, 2026, it will be necessary to pay (a) delinquent penalties, (b) costs, (c) redemption penalties, and (d) a redemption fee. After 5 years of tax delinquency, the Tax Collector has the power to sell tax-defaulted property that is not redeemed.

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
